Research Proposal Preparation Workshop

Madan Bhandari University of Science and Technology (MBUST) organized a Research Proposal Preparation Workshop for its staff. The objective of the workshop was to enhance the capacity of the staff in developing research proposals. To enhance the effectiveness of the workshop, the workshop is organized in three sessions separated by the preparation time required for subsequent sessions. The first session of the workshop was held on March 28, 2023, at Center of Energy Studies, Institute of Engineering (IOE), Pulchowk. The purpose of the first session was to provide guidance for the preparation of good research proposals in their areas of interest aligned to the priorities of MBUST. The participants will prepare and submit their proposals for review by resource persons within three weeks. The proposals should be suitable for seeking research grants from specific research funding agencies. In the second session of the workshop comments on the proposals will be shared with the participants for strengthening their proposals. Revised proposals from the participants will be submitted to the resource persons ahead of the third session. The participants will present the proposals in the third session.
