BRIEF NOTES ON THE MEETING ON THE HIKING TRAIL FROM CHANDRAGIRI HILL TO CHITLANG ALONG THE RIDGES

Summary of Discussions:

- 1. Opening a trekking route along the ridges from Chandragiri Cable Car Hilltop Station to Chitlang should increase the tourist flow into Chitlang, hence this project should be implemented.
- 2. The Chitlang community was ready to support this initiative. Nepal Tourism Board is also committed to supporting this initiative.
- 3. The following existing and potential tourism products associated with Chitlang were mentioned during the meeting:
 - a. Cultural heritage
 - b. Agriculture
 - c. Bird watching
 - d. Variety of orchid, plants, and flowers
 - e. Scenic view
 - f. Tourism packages of two nights three days and five nights six days including Chitlang, Markhu, Tistung, Palung, Daman and Simbhanjyang, etc.
 - g. The importance of developing trekking routes comfortable to hikers without negative impact on the environment was underscored.
 - h. The cooperation between the Chitlang community and the university community on the trail project should help to further enhance the close ties between the university and Chitlang community.
 - i. The trail should be designed using the state of the art knowledge and should serve as an example of a safe and attractive trail to a variety of hikers.
 - j. Maintenance and management aspects of the trail should be given due importance right from the conception through design, supervision, and commissioning phases.

- k. Initiatives are necessary for the rehabilitation of historical trails passing through Chitlang.
- I. Ecotourism should be promoted in Chitlang. MBUST should conduct research in this area also.
- m. Following the decline, during the COVID the tourist flow has started to increase in Chitlang but it may not last for long unless tourism is professionalized. MBUST should help in this through research.
- n. The bat cave, about 150m below the proposed trail, should also be connected to the trail for increasing its attractiveness.
- o. Due consultations should be made with forest authorities in the process of the design of the trail.
- p. The need for promotion and conservation of religious and cultural heritages, organic agriculture and commercial activities, and good education was also emphasized.
- 4. Mr. Labsher Bista, Mayor, Thaha Municipality briefly attended the meeting. Mr. Parshuram Shrestha, War Chairperson spoke at the meeting on behalf of Ward 9 of Thaha Municipality and Prof. Rajendra Dhoj Joshi, Board Chairperson on behalf of Madan Bhandari University of Science and Technology (MBUSTDB). From the side of MBUSTDB, Prof. Bhakta Bahadur Ale and Dr. Jagat Kumar Shrestha made presentation on the concept of the trail. Mr. Shambhu Adhikari conducted the meeting. The presentations are attached.
- 5. The meeting was jointly organized by the Ward 9 of Thaha Municipality and MBUSTDB. The organizers acknowledge the cooperation extended to the meeting by Chitlang Organic Village Resort, local tourism entrepreneurs and community, Dr. Jagat Kumar Shrestha and Mr. Rabi Jung Pandey among others.

Ariel view of Chitlang village and ridges from Chandragiri Hill.



The approximate distance from Chandragiri Hill (cable car station) to the ridge of MBUST is about 3 km.



The distance from Chandragiri Hill to the MBUST site is roughly 4 km but it will be longer after considering switchback (low slope bend) for a comfortable hike.



The approximate distance from Chandragiri Hill to Chitlang motorable road is more than 4 km. It may be about 6 km if the route is made considering the switchback for a comfortable walk.

The tentative distance from Chandragiri Hill to Markhu (boat riding station) varies from 8-10 km depending on the nature of the trekking route. It will be shorter if we consider the straight route but a difficult one and it may be longer but comfortable if the design avoids the steep climb up or climb down.
