The first BOT meeting held on Jestha 27, 2080 (June 10, 2023) has elected Mr. Padma Jyoti the Chairperson of the BOT. Among the duties and responsibilities of the BOT are adopting plans, policies and strategies for developing the University into a world-class university, appointing the President of the University (CEO), mobilizing resources and safeguarding norms and values in its operations.

The preparations for the establishment of the University started in Baishakh 2076 (May 2019) with the establishment of the Madan Bhandari University of Science and Technology Development Board. The University was established in August 2022 upon promulgation of the Madan Bhandari University of Science and Technology Act, 2079 (2022 AD).

The University is envisioned as a world-class research-oriented university aimed at helping build prosperous Nepal by producing capable technical and scientific human resources and enhancing the competitiveness of Nepalese economy through the creation and adaption of knowledge and technology to suit the local context.

The University is preparing to start research-based Master's and PhD programs designed to focus on real-life needs of the country from December 1, 2023 at Chitlang in the Makwanpur District.
